Introduction.

Thank you for your support of Grenite® products. Grenite® is the new standard for eco-responsible solid surfaces. Made from up to 80% recycled content, Grenite turns materials destined for landfills into new, useful, beautiful products.

With a little care, Grenite® products will deliver long lasting beauty and superior performance compared to traditional solid surfaces and laminates. However Grenite products are not indestructible. These simple care and maintenance instructions will help you get the best performance from your Grenite products.

Maintenance.

In all applications, Grenite products do not require special maintenance procedures. Regular cleaning hot water (without soap or detergent) and a soft cotton cloth is all that is required.

DO NOT use strong alkaline, acid or oxidizing cleaners, whether high, neutral or low pH) on Grenite.

DO NOT use or expose Grenite to bleach, oven cleaners, Comet®, Soft Scrub®, SOS®, pumice, batteries, paint remover, furniture strippers, tarnish or silver cleaners and similar products.

DO NOT apply sealers, penetrants or topical treatments to Grenite surfaces. Such products will wear off and cause the finish to dull.

Scratches.

Particular care should be taken when working with "scratches." What appears to be a scratch in the Grenite is generally a trail of material left on the Grenite by the scratching object. Gentle, patient cleaning will usually remove the "scratch." CAUTION: Overly ambitious cleaning on Grenite can mar the surface finish.

Care.

- Never cut directly upon the Grenite surface; use a cutting board.
- Never place a hot cooking utensil directly from the stove or oven on the Grenite surface; use a trivet.
- Never allow a staining material to sit and "set-up" on the surface; wipe immediately with water and towel dry.



Water and a soft cloth clean Grenite products best.



Grenite does not require special maintenance.
